WYSA League: We are still looking for a replacement representative to WYSA. Molalla Youth Sports has a great business size card that they are using in the sideline control arena. The card, modeled after one used by Hillsboro Soccer, is double sided with a wonderful description of what a spectator's role is at a game and on the reverse is the explanation why the card was given to the spectator. In essence, the referees carry the cards and when presented with a spectator that is a little "out of bounds" behavior wise, the referee can walk over and present the card to the offender. No words are needed. Molalla uses a fluorescent orange color for the card with black writing for their cards. It was felt that Canby should consider printing some up for our club use. The idea was

endorsed by the board but needs inform form the referrer coordinator. The board will ask Erin to follow up with Molalla.

Micro League:

Rec League: Registration: Online registration is under way. There are some glitches but on the whole it is a step in the right direction. People are already using the system. Our walk in registration is scheduled for Thursday, June 7 from 6-8 pm at Knight School. Summer Soccer registration will be held that night as well.

Rec League Opportunities: We desperately need several people to step forward and make a 2-year commitment to oversee the following areas for Rec League...Uniforms, and Equipment. She will not be around to coordinate rec league during summer 2008 for a while during the most crucial times for the league.

Field Painting: There is a need to revisit having the coaches paint fields on a weekly basis, as it is not working.
