The Rec League Committee met Monday, Jan 7 at Erin's house. The committee is working wonderfully.

Online registration for Spring Rec Soccer is going on now through Feb. 15.

Walk in registration is scheduled for Weds, Jan. 23 at Knight School from 6:15-8:15 pm. Registrations are being taken for 2nd – 8th grade players. 2nd grade players are being blended in to the 3rd grade teams for spring play. Postcards were sent out to the club for Spring Re Soccer. As well, signs were purchased and set up around town for advertisement. The newspaper is running a brief in the sports section.

Spring teams will be set by the committee on Feb 17 and will be sent to WYSA by the 18th.

The spring coaches' meeting will be held on March 3. Rosters, equipment, etc will be distributed then.

Rec equipment will be inventoried after spring season.

Rec League did purchase 50 size #4 balls for the spring season.

Spring Rec Soccer Parent Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 11. Time and

location to be determined. This will be a mandatory meeting for parents to attend. Uniform sales for spring will occur only at the Parent Meeting. Uniforms have been inventoried and new blue kits will be ordered for spring for the U9 teams. While U10 –U14 will still use yellow and black uniforms for spring, no new kits will be ordered. In stock jerseys will be sold to new players for \$10.00 to clear out the inventory we have (which is very limited). Players will be encouraged to borrow jerseys from kids not playing to get through this last season of use.

We have requested field space for Spring Rec from Carol and John at Canby Kids and from Tom Zauner from the club.

We will need the field crew to set up 2 small fields, 1 medium field, and 1 large field by March 15.

Classic Report: The Classic's program is "gearing up" for the spring league. In order to provide more options for players the program is increasing its efforts of advertising itself and what they have to offer. They are recommending purchasing signs and creating a special logo. It was moved and approved that the program can spend their budget allotment of up to \$1,000 for signs, logo, and advertisement to promote the program. Most of this effort will be focused toward tryouts. The program is also reaching out to neighboring community to pull great numbers so more teams and options can be organized.
